Meeting was called to order at 8:00 am.

Bills presented by Jim Corrie

Bills were approved.

There was a total of 136 calls for the month.

Payment is needed up front for an ambulance. Looking into military vs standard. Cost is cheaper but may not meet all KKK-A-1822 VF standards.

Billing meeting will be either the 11<sup>th</sup> or the 13<sup>th</sup>. Have turned in aging reports to hospital committee for review and any needed questions or concerns at time of meeting.

Since departure of Mason District Director, the paramedic class with ICC is on hold. Have been in contact with WIU. Agreed to do a sponsorship which will allow students to complete task here as well as Macomb. Also, should lower the cost from around \$2,100.00 per semester to approximately \$1,800.00 a semester. Looking at 3 semesters. Others are partnering with Lincoln Land and may be able to seek reimbursement from St. Johns due to lack of paramedics.

EMPG received 18547.60 for the first four quarters. Looking at receiving four to five thousand for the 5<sup>th</sup> quarter. Fifth quarter allows for the state to release what they can.

Received quotes from GEM City Ford in Quincy to fix 3B17. Will use EMS operations fund to complete the repair.

GEMT need to get the exact numbers filled out. Going through all expenses and usure of equipment to determine an exact amount along with usage of Ambulances.

Went into executive session at 8:40 to 8:51
